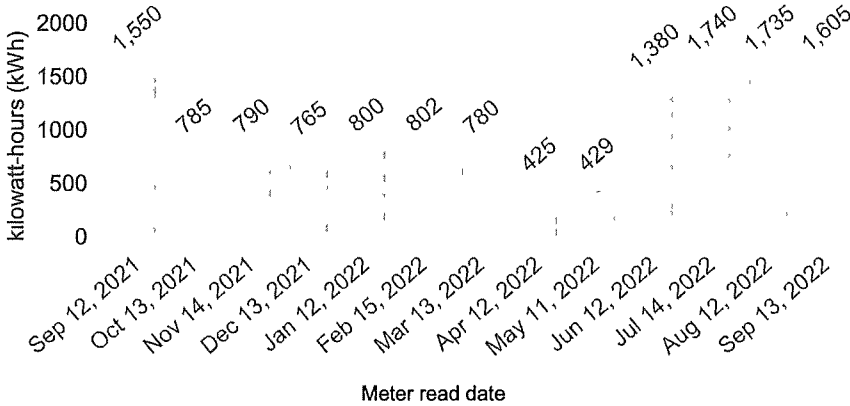

As a Budget Billing customer, your payment amount is the same each month. However, if you add a hot tub, electric space heater or other appliances, your energy usage will increase without you noticing it. Watch how much you use from month to month at "Total kWh" in the "Your Current Electricity Charges" section on page three of your bill. If the amount is consistently higher than in the past, consider calling us to reevaluate your Budget Billing payment amount so you don't have a big increase at the end of the Budget Billing year in August.

Bill explanation FYI: On the "Budget Bill" box on page one, the "Budget Bill Balance" is how much you would owe PNM if the amount is positive and if Budget Billing was canceled before paying this bill. If the amount is negative, that is how much PNM would owe you. Energy usage for most customers varies because of seasonality and other reasons, so the Budget Bill Balance can change throughout the year. Thanks for being a Budget Billing customer.
