## PNM customers can apply for bill assistance June 25 at the ABQ RIDE Summer Resource Fair

(Albuquerque, NM) – PNM will be providing bill assistance on Wednesday, June 25 from 10 a.m. to 1 p.m. at the ABQ RIDE Summer Resource Fair, hosted by the City of Albuquerque, at the Alvarado Transportation Center located at 100 1<sup>st</sup> St., Albuquerque, NM 87102. Income qualified PNM customers with a past-due bill or disconnect notice on their PNM bill and PNM customers over 60 years old who meet income qualifications can apply to receive help.

At this event, PNM will provide bill assistance through the PNM Good Neighbor Fund to eligible customers, energy efficiency tips and resources to help reduce energy costs, and information for upcoming financial literacy courses to help manage finances.

PNM customers applying for assistance should bring their past-due PNM bill or disconnect notice, or their current PNM bill if they are over 60 years of age, plus proof of participation in LIHEAP or SNAP for the current year, and a valid ID matching the name on the PNM account.
